School Vision:

Our vision is for all students to develop at Woodlem Park School as independent learners with self-belief and respect for others with a lifelong love for learning and a strong foundation for future success.

At Woodlem Park School we value every student. We provide the best possible learning opportunities in academic subjects, personal development, moral values, and life skills. Staff members and students work together in a spirit of cooperation and mutual harmony.

Aim Scope & Significance:

- A choice in Second Language is introduced in Grade 1 which offers options to choose one from Hindi, French, Tamil & Malayalam. The same language continues up to Grade 10. Thus, it culminates in the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). Hence, choice of second language must be made very carefully & thoughtfully in grade 1.
- If for some reason a change in Second Language is required for the next academic year, a written request must be made to the Principal by 10th January.
- Please note, no change will be entertained during the year.
- Change of second language will also depend on the availability of seats.
- Change in second language is permitted only till grade 5. Students who wish to change their second language must appear for the Entry Level Test to determine competency and proficiency in the language being opted for at the end of the academic year. Syllabus can be provided for the same. The test will be conducted at the end of January. Change to Tamil or Malayalam will be made for native speakers only.
- In the case of change to French, the student can be supported by extra support material, but no separate classes can be arranged.
- Ordinarily, no change in second language will be permitted from grade 6 onwards. However, in special circumstances, an appeal may be made to the School Principal for consideration. Making appeal will have no guarantee of changing the second language.
- The second language registered in grade 9 cannot be changed in grade 10 in any circumstances.

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
